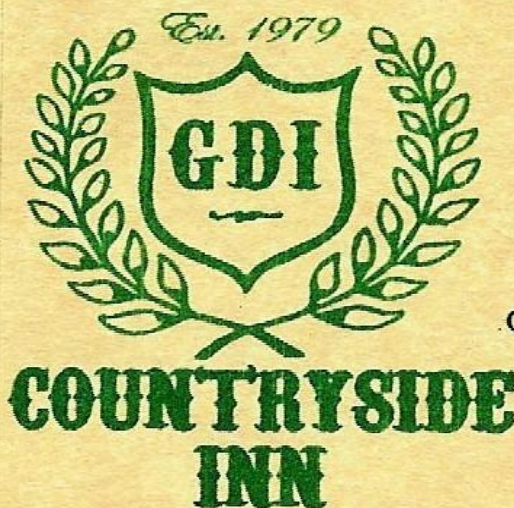

Whether you're new to the sport or an old pro—sometimes it's good to brush up on snowmobile safety. There's a lot of good resources on the web that have information about safe riding. The NYSSA website (www.nyssnowassoc.org) has a side bar under the main menu dedicated to snowmobile safety. Clicking on it will bring up a drop down menu with pages about groomer awareness, hand signals, Safe Riders! training and other beneficial information every rider should know.

The best recommendation is to take the snowmobile safety course offered by one of the local clubs. At the very least, check out the Safe Riders! training on the web—it is a self guided website that goes through basic snowmobile safety. 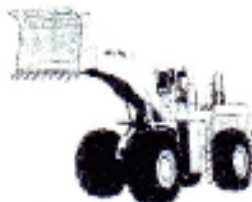
