

I hope everyone's enjoying your summer. Granted, the rain has certainly made it difficult for summer activities but it still seems like the time flew by.

Even in the summer we here at NESS still meet and plan for the never-ending tasks that need to be done. As I've said a thousand times before, the one major goal we have is to provide the best riding experience in WNY. That's sounds pretty simple but there's a lot more to it than simply riding.

As you know, our riding season is short and, when it finally arrives, we get out and maintain our trails almost continuously. In fact, last year, we spent nearly 18 hours *a day* grooming when the snow was here. Not bad for a bunch of volunteers who also want to ride and have other responsibilities too! Even with a schedule like that, we asked: "what can we do to improve that?"

Keeping in line with that goal, we continually review what we've done or haven't done to make this club work. Even with the nearly around-the-clock schedule we've had it still, at times, did not give us the product we wanted. Grooming seems to be the most labor and equipment intensive activity we have and, with 125 miles of trail, even the "experts" tell us we fall short in that department. So.... I'm glad to announce that we've made a decision to purchase another groomer!!

A lot of thought and work went in to this decision but we've come up with a plan that'll work if everyone does their part. After reviewing many options, visiting dealers, and asking clubs all around the country, we've chosen to go with a Piston Bully Trail. Its looks similar to our current groomer but has a few features better suited for our trail system. Given the cost, performance, reliability, and long-term needs of the club, it was the best unit we could find.

As I said, this is a big event and we'll need everyone's commitment. A few of our members have already stepped up and offered to help. We plan to have it ready for the upcoming season and will be rolling out several programs to help us pay for it! Details will be coming but I'm excited about this and hope you are too! We look forward to once again raising the bar and hope everyone can support that goal!

Safety Corner

Registration season is upon us. Any snowmobile operated in New York State must be registered with the NYS DMV even if it is registered in another state (there are exceptions that do apply). Registration and proof of insurance must be carried on their person at all times when snowmobiling. These documents are required to be produced should a law enforcement officer request them or at the request of anyone who is injured or suffers property damage as the result of the operation of the snowmobile.


