Upon completion, you will receive a NYS operator certificate allowing you to operate a snowmobile on public lands. We are limited to 50 students so sign up early. | Person or Conn. | APPROADON | Season Borane |
|-------------------|-----------|--|
| Right Turn | ST. | Left arm raised at shoulder height, elbow bent, and forearm vertical with palm of hand flat. |
| Left Turn | A | Left arm extended straight out from shoulder and pointing in the direction of the turn. |
| Stop | Ra | Arm raised from the shoulder and extended up over the head with palm of hand flat. |
| Slowing | 60 C | Left arm extended out and down from the side of the body with a downward flapping motion of hand to signal warning or caution. |
| Oncoming Sleds | Ş | Left arm raised at shoulder height, elbow bent and forearm vertical, wrist bent, move arm from left to right over head, pointing to right side of trail. |
| Sleds Following | (E) | Arm raised, elbow bent with thumb pointing backward in hitch-hiking motion move arm forward to backward over your shoulder. |
| Last Sled in Line | F | Left arm raised at shoulder height, elbow bent and forearm vertical with hand clenched in a fist. |




