Here we are

I want to thank everyone who contacted our elected officials about the proposed sweep of our trail fund money. Our voices were heard and there will be <u>no</u> pilfering of our funds this year! Now we have to change the verbiage that allows such a foolish thing to begin with so it will never be a threat again. Our quest continues...your letters and calls to Albany are always welcome.

As we prepare for another season, I asked the board to come up with a list of projects we would like to do this year forward. We did not include the "daily" activities of running the club but other, non-standard activities or projects that make our club one of the best in WNY. From a large list we combined items, categorized them, and came up with a pretty decent "to do" list. If any of this sounds familiar, it is. Several years ago we did just the same thing. I'm also happy to report that ALL of those have been completed! The new \$170,000 groomer was probably the biggest project on that list!

Here's a brief summary of what we have for this round:

- More club rides and functions. Dice runs, family rides, cookouts, etc. These are always good things and we'll be looking for volunteers to help arrange them and make them successful.
- Establish better committees with clearer responsibilities. Hats off to the people we have now who have done a won-derful job in the past but we think it time to support them even more by defining it better.
- Consider a 2nd UTV for trail maintenance. Isn't it awesome that we blanket WNY with over 125 mile of trials? I do too but having just 1 machine to mark and maintain it can be a bit challenging. Now that we have a newer side-by-side, we found the perfect machine to look for!
- Reward volunteers. We have to still come up with a system that's fair to all but our goal is to recognize and reward those who make ALL this happen and allow us to ride our sleds on a beautiful trail system right in our backyard. There is so much more to say but that would take a book!
- Grow and further improve our grooming functions. We spent nearly 16 hours of every "groomable" day last year grooming our trails even though that's about a 1000% increase over 10 years ago, we want to make sure its spread out evenly and with the best possible results. The music plays for only about 8 weeks and we want to be dancing when it does!

Of course, all of this takes people. The more the better. I've lost track of how many times I've said that but the tasks above are not really that hard when you have a group of dedicated people who all share the load. I believe getting them is the biggest task we have.

Don't forget to come and help out at the annual Labor Day fair! Please call 741-NESS to sign up! We need volunteers for an hour or two – we have some huge events planned!







- <u>3)</u> Eric Glassman has the trailer plate and the ATV plate. Is the plate is transferrable? Rich McNamara will take care of it


Other:
