





Meeting called to order at 7:10 PM - 14 people present Meeting ended at 8:45 PM

Review from last meeting:

- 1) Signs are ordered. Bill needs a few "STOP" signs. Bill has about 25 blank brown/yellow signs. Eric could use about 6 of them. The bike path needs confirming signs and trailheads. We have some blank yellow vinyl signs. Eric will have Steve print some up for the trails.
- 2) We had a meeting at the Akron Fire Hall regarding a disaster plan on Tuesday, December 7th. Most officers and board members were present.

Trails:
