

Objective of committee formation: Our club has the following committees to help utilize our membership and to make the process easy for you to get involved. We have tried to simplify and specify the responsibilities of our hard working volunteers.

- 1. **Legal Committee:** Responsibilities include handling our by-laws, insurance, legal actions and correspondence.
- 2. <u>Emergency Response Committee:</u> Help our communities in their time of need. Responsibilities would include coordinating, on our club side, a disaster response team including groomers, equipment and sleds.
- **3. PR/Marketing & Advertising Committee:** Responsibilities include signs, selling ads for newsletters and trail head advertising.
- **4. Fundraising Committee:** Fundraising items including coupon books, raffles, 50/50 and groomer boxes.
- 5. <u>Apparel Committee:</u> Responsibilities include ordering and distributing our NESS apparel.
- **6.** <u>Social Committee:</u> Responsibilities include organization of all activities including Buck's open house, Don George's open house, Labor Day Fair booth, Labor Day Fair Pizza, Bon Fire, Christmas Party, Club rides, and Summer Events
- 7. <u>Membership Committee:</u> Responsibilities include receiving applications and processing memberships. Producing vouchers for sled registrations and decals with the temporary NESS membership cards. Responsibilities would also include distributing applications to various locations around town.
- **8.** Groomer/UTV Equipment Committee: Responsibilities include keeping the groomers and drags in working order, organizing the grooming schedules for the winter and organizing groomer education/safety courses. Keeping UTV in working order and organizing UTV usage for trail work.
- **9.** <u>Trail/Landowner Committee:</u> Responsibilities include coordination the county trail captains to see that their 3 or 4 mile stretch of trail is being taken care of and handling all landowner issues and requests. All trail openings and closings are determined by this committee. Erie County Niagara County
- 10. <u>Trail Guides Committee:</u> Responsibilities include distribute maps to establishments and collecting \$.
- 11. <u>Newsletter Committee:</u> Responsibilities would include creating each month and coordinate input from others and have ready to print our newsletter for either print or website.
- **12.** Website Committee: Responsibilities would include moderating and update with activities and club news. Keeping the website functional and register users for site.
- **13.** <u>Safety/Education Committee:</u> Responsibilities would include Setting up, organizing and running our courses and discussions at meetings.
- 14. Adopt-A-Highway Committee: Coordinate Fall & Spring clean-ups on Rt. 93 in Akron.

- 2) Erie Federation. State registrations are down 25% this year look for this to impact the trail funding. The state is working on online registrations for out of state and Canada this will make it easier for others to ride our State system. There may be a change in deer season. - 3) Genesee Federation meeting was cancelled.

- 1) We should look at our Marine insurance to see if the values have changed so our cost would be lower.
- 2) Sandy suggests we get the bills of the club presented, have a discussion, vote to pay and then issue checks.
- 3) Mercy Flight. We made a donation a few months ago and John thought we would like a few more details about their charity. John G. mentions they have 3 helicopters. They can travel anywhere in 15 minutes. It costs \$6.5 million for a new one. They sold their 3 old ones to an oil company in Argentina. They helped 20,000 patients with severe trauma or life/death situations. 24/7, with 13 pilots, 22 paramedics and nurses. They provide a great service.

- 4) We are updating our Contact List and Attendance sheets. Mary Beth will have new ones at next meeting.






