FROM THE TRAIL COORDINATOR SIDE

The following is an overview of the NYSSA forum that we attended last month. On Saturday morning we sat in on the first seminar which covered the budget for NYSSA. Roger explained to us that they are trying to limit the expenses due to there is a limit on money coming in due to the number of sleds registered. He said the forum next year will be in ROCHESTER, which will be a good location due to everything is in walking distance from the hotel which will eliminate a parking problem. The next seminar was PR101 which was put on by Gramercy Communications. They discussed ways or how to conduct an interview with a reporter when the club my have either an accident or want to promote something positive that the club does or did for the community. That you should always get all your facts together before you say or comment on anything because everyone always assumes that when there is an accident it always involves alcohol and speed. They recommend that the club should have a spokes person that would handle these situations.

Then I sat in on ENCOURAGING YOUTH AND VOLUNTEERS. This was put on with the help of KAOS Kids and ADULTS ON SNOWMOBILES. They gave us ideas on how to keep the younger generation involved with you and the club. One idea that they had was to tape record one of your meetings and then listen to yourself. Then the question was would you sit thru that. They recommended that you have shorter meetings and then have activities afterwards which involve the kids then the parents could socialize. The kids said that they are trying to replace the graying work force that is out there. And if you don't believe just look at the ones sitting in this meeting room...... They also Recommended that the club invest time in to facebook or other communications to keep up with the times and not what you used to do years ago. T

Then we attended the Annual meeting on Sunday morning. The first item was an increase on memberships fee which was quickly voted down after many tries. They also covered how the clubs are entitled to file for any fuel tax that they are paying for. The state recommends that the clubs list landowners as members that way they get all the newsletters and magazines that show what is good in snowmobiling. They also discussed the insurance coverage has been raised to help in protecting the landowners. We then voted on the new officers and closed the meeting.

Thanks to everyone who helped. We couldn't have been successful without the support form our members. Our Spring date was on April 28th at 9:00 am at Niagara Label.



Objective of committee formation: Our club has the following committees to help utilize our membership and to make the process easy for you to get involved. We have tried to simplify and specify the responsibilities of our hard working volunteers.

- 1. <u>Legal Committee:</u> Responsibilities include handling our by-laws, insurance, legal actions and correspondence.
- 2. <u>Emergency Response Committee:</u> Help our communities in their time of need. Responsibilities would include coordinating, on our club side, a disaster response team including groomers, equipment and sleds.
- **3. PR/Marketing & Advertising Committee:** Responsibilities include signs, selling ads for newsletters and trail head advertising.
- **4. Fundraising Committee:** Fundraising items including coupon books, raffles, 50/50 and groomer boxes.
- 5. **Apparel Committee:** Responsibilities include ordering and distributing our NESS apparel.
- **6.** <u>Social Committee:</u> Responsibilities include organization of all activities including Buck's open house, Don George's open house, Labor Day Fair booth, Labor Day Fair Pizza, Bon Fire, Christmas Party, Club rides, and Summer Events
- 7. <u>Membership Committee:</u> Responsibilities include receiving applications and processing memberships. Producing vouchers for sled registrations and decals with the temporary NESS membership cards. Responsibilities would also include distributing applications to various locations around town.
- **8.** Groomer/UTV Equipment Committee: Responsibilities include keeping the groomers and drags in working order, organizing the grooming schedules for the winter and organizing groomer education/safety courses. Keeping UTV in working order and organizing UTV usage for trail work.
- **9.** Trail/Landowner Committee: Responsibilities include coordination the county trail captains to see that their 3 or 4 mile stretch of trail is being taken care of and handling all landowner issues and requests. All trail openings and closings are determined by this committee. Erie County Niagara County
- 10. <u>Trail Guides Committee:</u> Responsibilities include distribute maps to establishments and collecting \$.
- 11. <u>Newsletter Committee:</u> Responsibilities would include creating each month and coordinate input from others and have ready to print our newsletter for either print or website.
- **12.** Website Committee: Responsibilities would include moderating and update with activities and club news. Keeping the website functional and register users for site.
- **13.** <u>Safety/Education Committee:</u> Responsibilities would include Setting up, organizing and running our courses and discussions at meetings.


