


Date / Time / Location:	July 30th., 2020 @ Rich M. Office on Roll Rd. (7:00pm)

Trails & Landowners	It was decided to send out landowner permission cards at the October Meeting Al brought us up to speed on the issue regarding the Dibble RR and the lots and houses being built. We may need to do some brushing to create a new access point to get on the RR bed, Billy P. had contacted AL in regards to one of the houses regarding this issue, Al had been to the Alden town offices, and looked at Tax maps, he has some names and contact info. Al also advised of issues up in Niagara county, the bridge we need to build / replace. Also, he advised that we need to do some serious brush hogging on pretty much all of Niagara county trail. Bridge needs to be installed between Crosby & Schafer Rd's NYS Thruway issues were discussed, we may need to obtain a permit to put that trail back where it was, we need to re-evaluate the situation there and go from there.	
Power Line Project	Ron & Rich brought everyone up to speed on the (2) meetings they have had with the company that is responsible for expanding the power lines, and adding the new poles and power lines. This effects our trail system in a few areas, and the project starts $01/01/2021$, so we will have to work with them through our upcoming season. The biggest effect will be our trail head, trail intersection in the Block church Rd & Rte #93 area. Ron & Rich have another meeting scheduled for Aug 17th This project will be completed in 1 year. There was a great deal of discussion on this topic, this will be an ongoing issue, that will we will have to deal with through this up coming season.
