# Editors Thoughts, Notes & Idea's

In last months newsletter, in my editorial page, in regards to the NYSSA's proposed changes to recommend to the New York State Office of Parks & Recreation I got a few things wrong. And I was called out on it, as I should be. So, I'm here this month to clarify some things & apologize. When and if I'm wrong, I'm not afraid to acknowledge it. With that said, at the time I wrote the newsletter (2+ weeks before its delivered in the mail) SOME of what I wrote was accurate, but honestly it was changing by the day. And by the time you read it, it was wrong.

\* NYS Parks did not request NYSSA to come up with a new trail fund distribution plan. When NYS Parks announced they we're going to change the trail fund, NYSSA took action, with the feeling they were best suited to make a recommendation.

\* NYSSA did not form the "trails committee" just to work on the trail grant issue. In fact, the trails committee has always been one of the many committees that are part of the NYSSA.

\*The NYSSA trails committee was thrown a bit of a curve ball, once they started working on a new trail grant proposal, NYS Parks notified them that all the data for the previous 10+ years, in regards to the trail grant had been lost or deleted.

\* I made the statement that funding will be cut to all clubs across the state. This statement is still controversial today. Why? mainly because there is no accurate way to compare the proposed new trail grant(s) to the old trail grant. The only accurate statement I feel I can make at this point is, if passed, the new trail grant process could potentially payout more to our club in good snow years, and less in low snow years.

\* I used the word "tremendous" to describe the desire for clubs in high snow areas to have access to more money for grooming in the new trail grant proposals. I overstated., In my opinion there has been a desire for these clubs to get more money out of the trail grant for grooming, but tremendous was overstating my point.

\* I asked for club members to go to the NYSSA Annual Forum to represent, NESS, Erie County & WNY snowmobilers. I did not have permission from the other clubs of Erie County, nor the snowmobilers in general of WNY to have our clubs attendees represent them at the forum.

...Final thoughts... There is a big disclaimer on the bottom of this page, it's there because what I write here is my opinion, and the way I see it. I got some things wrong last month, but I also made some waves with what I had correct, and those waves traveled across the whole state. And those waves may have helped change the tide.






