

I'm very glad to report that there have been very few problems, incidences & complaints in regards to snowmobilers staying on the marked trail and following the posted signage. NESS trail captains pound in 3,000+ trail



marker stakes, and hang close to 2,000 trail signs. They do all that to keep you safe, protect our landowners property and remind snowmobilers to act respectful and responsible toward homeowners and landowners close to our trails. As I crisscross our trails, in the groomers, and by way of snowmobile, I've been very impressed with everyone following the marked trail, and staying between the stakes. In the most sensitive & dangerous sections of our trail system, where the NEXTERA workers are, there have been no issues or complaints. We have weekly conversations with the folks at NEXTERA, and they have been very happy with the snowmobiles crossing their sections of trail. In the fields where farmers have winter crops planted, snowmobiles have stayed on the marked trail, even though it's not the most convenient route. Our biggest complaint, as always, NOISE... Loud snowmobiles are an issue, like they are everywhere, but for NESS it goes beyond that. Our trails pass through some very residential areas. Please, please be mindful of your actions out on our trails. How you ride, is a reflection on all snowmobilers. As I'm sure your aware, there has been a SERIOUS crack down on altered & loud snowmobile exhaust, don't be part of the problem that closes trails.... Be part of the solution to keep trails open, keep the stock exhaust in place on your sled, and be aware of your surroundings before you pin the throttle to the bars... Save that for the wide open fields, where it's much safer, and will not effect public relations. "Thank YOU"
