\* Norfolk Southern RR tracks crossing between Broadway & Westwood Rd. Are you sick of riding East to Darien / Alexander just so you can get South ? Help us get that trail opened back up.

\* Trail S41E ("Pizza Inn" trail) Do you live in Clarence Center and use that trail? Guess what, it's <u>CLOSED</u> unless we find a re-route. You may want to find out what's going on there.

\* Niagara County, C4H / S46 North of Bunker Hill Rd. will not be groomed this season <u>UNLESS</u> the limbs and brush are trimmed back, and trail widened out in the Terrys Corners Fire Hall area of that trail. We can't fit through there anymore with the groomers, it's just to tight.

\* Niagara County, C4D North / West of Simms Rd. going West to Riddle Rd., bridge is unsafe, and we have lost permission, if a re-route isn't found there will be 5+ miles of road riding to get around it.

\* C4C East of Knapp Rd. (The Peanut Power Lines), does that section always have 3' moguls, and water holes when you ride it ? ... It's because we need to regrade the stone base, and cut drainage in it. We've done it in the past, and it makes a huge difference, it's just time to flatten it out again. We need someone with a dozer and time to fix that up.
