He's spent the last few weeks racking up the hours, mowing down, and clearing out & widening sections of trail that have become overgrown over the years. It may seem like a waist of time, but years of experience have taught us that creating a clear definite path



through the tall grass, ding weeds, and brush helps a great deal to keep snowmobiles where they belong, and away from sensitive or dangerous areas. It also exposes dangerous objects that may be lying below eyesight, like big rocks, down trees, & branches that can't be seen once the blanket of snow covers the trails. Safety and an enjoyable riding experience is our number one goal. Tree limbs that grow in on the trails pose a real danger to our groomers, and their operators. A new

windshield for one of the Pisten Bully's is \$5,000, and has to be direct shipped from Germany !!!
