Tail Captains

In the past few years we have gained some new trail captains, the groomer operators would like to remind

everyone marking trail to keep in mind the groomers are 40+ feet long, 8 feet wide and 10 feet tall. The groomer operators all pride themselves on their awesome abilities to snake through some very tight trails...BUT... Often times, it's trail markers and trail signs, that create problems for the grooming crew. Optimally we like to see trail markers no closer than 12 feet wide in the open sections of our trails and farm fields. In tight wood sections of our trails, be cautious where you place trail markers and signage, keep in mind, the sharper the corner is, the more real estate we need to get the groomer and drag around it. At trail intersections, pay extra attention, and evaluate how the intersection looks and measures from each way you approach it. We have gone to great extremes to brush hog out 60+loot circles at intersection locations, just so we can have enough room to negotiate turns, or change directions. Lastly, watch for branches and tree limbs, the groomers are roughly twice as tall as the roll cage on the club UTV's. Trail markers and signage is critical, and you put in a great deal of effort to install it, the ast thing we want to see is trail markers knocked down on the first grooming run.
